Dear Praying Friends,

Rejoice with Margaret and me at the birth of our grandson Ethan James Lytle. Born June 22, 2009, Ethan weighed in at 7 lbs 13 oz. and was 20 inches long. We were in the bush at Lawa when Ethan was born. There was a flight to our village the next day so we were able to get the news right away.



Later that week we went down river about an hour by dugout canoe to a village on the French Guiana side and were able to call Tim & Diane by phone and get all the details about the birth and to hear that mother and baby were doing fine.



Now that we are in the city, we have been able to talk more frequently with Tim & Diane and even hear Ethan gurgling and cooing in the background. We're waiting (not too patiently) for them to get Skype set up so that we can see him in real time. We don't know how long it will be before we can actually get our hands on him and begin the spoiling process. We praise the Lord for His gift of Ethan.

A team of two Wayana Indian couples have left Lawa and are now over in neighboring French Guiana among the Melejo Indians on the far south east corner. They are following up on earlier contacts deepening relationships with the people building upon the Word of God that has already been shared with them. Please pray for open hearts and understanding from the Spirit of God to liberating truths that will set these dear people free from the terrible bondage of sin. Language continues to be a great challenge to the outreach team. Please pray for Soko and Kuliman and Amepin and Susina. Amepin speaks French, so hopefully this will be very helpful in translating.

Please continue to pray for the outreach team that is being formed to go to the Zoe tribe down in north Brazil sometime in August. They are waiting to the rivers to go down for easier travel. Their last contact was discovered by government officials who are trying to prevent contact with outside sources. Pray that the Lord will open doors into this tribe that no man can shut. Pray that He will prepare the hearts of these dear people to receive His Word.
